CONNECTING AS PART OF A FINANCED EXPANSION PROJECT

The Clay Rural Water System periodically has access to outside financing from state, federal and other sources to finance construction costs for larger "Added User Projects"



Users are typically added in large groups of 30 or more. Projects are done every 3-5 years.

Following are the requirements for these projects. In addition new users must provide easements and rights-of-way.

Feasibility

The proposed user must meet feasibility requirements including engineering and total cost.

Hookup Fee

Pay a Hookup and Capacity Fee of \$1,235.00 (\$1,210.00 for current members). These fees pay for engineering, administrative, capacity and material costs.

Aid-to-Construction Fee

Pay an Aid-to-Construction Fee of \$400.00. This fee aids in the overall construction costs and reduces the amount of loan funds needed to finance the project.

Monthly/Annual Fee

Agree to pay the monthly/annual debt service

Meter Pit

If the user is unable to provide a frost proof location for the water meter, a meter pit may have to be installed at a cost of \$400.00.

Service Areas 43 & 44 Pipeline Assessment Fee

A special assessment of \$1,000 is charged for all new hookups in Distribution Service Area's 43 and 44 and paid to the Town of Gayville as compensation for the pipeline serving these areas.

CONNECTING AS AN INDIVIDUAL USER

Users who wish to connect on their own are required to pay all hookup and construction costs. Monthly charges commence following service installation. Following are the requirements for connection. In addition new users must provide easements and rights-of-way.

Hookup Fee \$1,235.00

Includes cost of membership (\$25.00), meter setter, mainline connection, service line valve and capacity charge (\$400.00). Existing members receive credit for the membership fee.

Meter Pit \$400.00

If the user is unable to provide a frost proof location for the water meter, a meter pit may have to be installed at a cost of \$400.00.

Service Areas 43 & 44 Pipeline Assessment Fee \$1,000.00

A special assessment is charged for all new hookups in Distribution Service Area's 43 and 44 and paid to the Town of Gayville as compensation for the pipeline serving these areas.

Serviceline Construction \$3.50

Serviceline runs from the metering point (basement or meter pit) to the mainline connection. Charges cover labor, materials and excavation.

Road Bores \$12.50

In the event it is necessary to bore under a hard surfaced road.

Mainline Construction \$3.50

Mainline parallels the public road or right-of-way. Charges cover labor, materials and excavation.
